

PUBLIC NOTICE

Section 17 (1) of the Medical and Dental Act No. 10 of 2004, provides that no person is entitled to practice within Namibia the profession of Biomedical Engineering unless that person is registered by the Medical and Dental Council of Namibia in terms of this Act to practice the profession concerned. Any person who contravenes this provision of the Act is guilty of an offence and upon conviction liable to the penalties specified in section 61(b) of the same Act.

The Medical and Dental Council of Namibia is therefore informing any unregistered person practising or intending to practice Biomedical Engineering in Namibia to immediately apply for registration as a Biomedical Engineer.
